SQUARE ONE WINTER

Friday 2nd – Sunday 4th June, 2023.

For whom? Square One is a camp where churches send a group of children (Years 3, 4, 5 and 6) and leaders for a weekend of relational discipleship through age-appropriate bible talks, small group time and lots of fun in activities and games. Invite children from Sunday school, kids club, SRE or school friends!

How much? \$230 per child, \$220 per leader, registration via youthworks.net/squareone. A payment plan option available which spreads the cost across weekly payments. There are also discounts available.

Why come? Square One is a unique opportunity for churches to give children a 'big camp' experience without planning and running it all yourself. **Children stay with their own church group and leaders** for the whole weekend, so they are always with friends and trusted leaders. What is the topic? This year the theme is **Transformed by Grace** (Titus 2:11-14) with talks by Ben Pakula. It’s going to be interactive and action-packed. We gather to hear the Bible taught in Big Gatherings; small group times that allow time for question and discussion; as well as ‘Me & God’ time each day that gives children the opportunity to reflect on God’s word independently.

What happens? Campers arrive on Friday evening (after dinner) to sign in and find their group leaders. Over the weekend, campers do a range of activities in their church groups. There are Gatherings with singing and bible teaching, Small group time and meals together. There are also activity times with outside games (sometimes messy), pool and waterslide (at the Spring camps), team challenges and more. On Sunday, sign out happens early afternoon and leaders and parents take campers home.

What about rooms? Rooms are allocated according to church groups. Some rooms may have campers sharing with other church groups. Leaders are aware of room allocations in advance and can ensure friends are together as much as possible. Leaders are in separate rooms nearby.
